

SERMON TOPIC & SCRIPTURE

"Mr. So and So" *Ruth 3:11-4:8*

Discipleship

I want to encourage and help you to reach new levels in your walk with God in the coming year. The key to spiritual growth is to meditate on God's Word "day and night" (Joshua 1:8). This does not mean studying the Bible twenty-four hours a day, but it does include doing six things Jesus led his disciples to do; 1. Regularly listen to preaching (Sunday morning), 2. Regularly participate in a small group Bi-ble study with discussion (like Sunday School), 3. Study the Bible (this involves more than reading, but reading while lis-tening for God's instruction). 4. Memo-rize key Bible verses, 5. Create specific applications from Bible study and put them into practice. 6. Follow a godly model's into practice. 6. Follow a godly model's example in spiritual growth.

In other words, you need the worship services and classes that our church offers, but you need more than that. These things do not take a significant amount of time, but they do require commitment and consistency. That's where I want to offer help. I will provide regular messages with Bible readings, memory verses, and sometimes practical assignments for you to fol-low in the New Year. The Bible reading plan will not cover the whole Bible, but selected books and portions of Scripture to read during the year. There will be a memory verse for each month and encouraging words. If you sign up to get the messages, I will also commit to pray for you regularly. You may choose to get the messages through e-mail, text or Facebook.
