### Sermon Topic and Scripture

"God Intended it for Good" Gen.37

### <u>Discipleship</u>

I highly recommend the book *Justification* and *Regeneration*, by Charles Leiter. No book contains such a vast amount of quotable material on the wonderful truths of the gospel in such a short work as this one. I will include a few selections from each topic over the next few weeks.

This week I will begin with sin. The more we understand sin, the more we rejoice at learning of the good news of the gospel:

"All sin flows from man's perverse desire to put himself in the place of God-to be the center and measure of all things and to "know" for himself what is good and what is evil."

"Far from recognizing this state of affairs, lost men imagine themselves to be 'basically good,' unless God in mercy reveals to them the true condition of their blackened hearts."

"A moment's reflection on the sins of our own past is enough to confirm that *none of them makes any sense*. Such was the insanity of the prodigal son's actions that his repentance involved nothing less than 'coming to his senses.' (Luke 15:17) *There is no wise sin.*"

"Every sinner is a fugitive from justice. Regardless of the present condition of his heart, he has *objective guilt*, outside himself, in the eyes of God's law. He may not have any 'guilt feelings,' but he stands "guilty" or "condemned," nevertheless.

"No matter how much men may try to suppress it, there is still an indelible knowledge in the human heart that *right* and *wrong*, are real, that men are *responsible* for their wrongdoing, and that sin *deserves* to be punished."

God's wrath is not a temporary loss of self -control or a selfish fit of emotion. It is His holy, white-hot hatred of sin, the reaction and revulsion of His holy nature against all that is evil."
