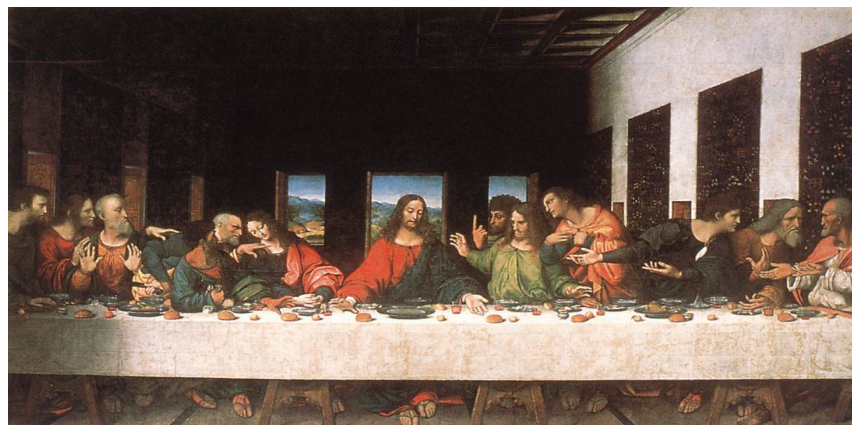

Sermon: Matthew 26:17-30

Discipleship:

“Woe to those who make unjust laws, to those who issue oppressive decrees.”- —Isiah 10

On Sunday nights we are looking at the role of the Bible for Christians when it comes to political issues. Here are some of the highlights of what we have studied so far:

- 1. The right to vote means that we have a certain amount of power to influence our government. All political power ultimately comes from God. Therefore, when we vote, we are using pow-

er that God has given us to influence our government. We should take this role seriously.

- 2. God has certain expectations and standards for what we do with political power. As Christians, we never want to be a part of those responsible for making “unjust laws,” as Isaiah warns against.
- 3. As followers of Jesus Christ who believe the Bible is the Word of God, we should seek to understand how various Scriptures relate to current political issues. We should stay informed about political issues so that we can use our right to vote in a way that honors God.

We will begin looking at some of those political issues from a biblical view this coming Sunday.
