NO Contradiction

The temple of Messiah does not replace the temple on earth. The Temple on earth only reflected the true Temple, which has always stood and yet still stands.

The Messiah serves in the eternal Temple above. He has taken over the high priesthood of that sanctuary. Therefore, we need not speak of Messiah’s priesthood replacing the Aaronic priesthood on earth. Our Master’s holy sacrifice and eternal priesthood applies to a completely different venue. His high priesthood is as far removed and above the priesthood of Aaron as the Temple in which he serves is removed and above the temple in Jerusalem.

In regard to the priesthood, then, the Torah actually has not been changed.

Messiah’s priesthood arbitrates over the new covenant, and we look to the intercession of his priesthood for salvation. This offers no contradiction to Torah or the work of the Aaronic priesthood.

Time of the Reformation

The writer of the book of Hebrews states that the Aaronic priesthood “is becoming obsolete and growing old is ready to vanish away” (Hebrews 8:13) along with the rest of this transient, fading, present world. That is because the Aaronic priesthood pertains to this present world, this material, physical state. The Aaronic priesthood offers rituals that “deal only with food and drink and various washings, regulations for the body imposed until the time of reformation” (Hebrews 9:10). What is “the time of reformation”? The “time of reformation can only be the transition

from this present world to the world to come at the end of the Messianic Era. In other words, the “time of the reformation” is the world to come.

The Torah is not “becoming obsolete and growing old, ready to disappear”; rather the entire present world along with its needful things will become obsolete when the Temple above descends to Earth as New Jerusalem in the world to come, there is no Temple: “And I saw no temple in the city, for its temple is the Lord God the Almighty and the Lamb” (Revelation 21:220). **From, “What About the Sacrifices” by D.
