

Sermon: Genesis 9:8-16 "A Covenant for All Generations"

Discipleship: Is There Only One True Religion? (Part 1)

From Prosperous and Successful by David Janaro

It's hard to say that there is only one right religion and all others are wrong. It sounds arrogant. Something about it makes us feel uncomfortable. However, the truth is what matters most, even if it doesn't always feel good. For instance, it may not be easy for a doctor to tell a patient that she will die without a difficult surgery, but it would be wrong for the doctor to keep that information a secret in order to avoid a difficult conversation.

The truth is that it is impossible for all religions to be right. According to Islam, I will go to hell when I die. I have committed blasphemy by worshiping Jesus as God while failing to recognize Mohammad as God's greatest prophet. According to Christianity, I will go to heaven because Jesus forgave all my sins when I trusted in him as my Lord and Savior. Hindu religions say I will be born again on this earth through reincarnation. Atheists say that my body will decay and there is nothing more to it. Only one of these can be right. I cannot simultaneously go to heaven and hell when I die. There is only one of me, and I have to go somewhere! As uncomfortable as it may make us feel, the inescapable conclusion is that the majority of people are wrong about the afterlife.

But is it possible to know which religion is true? Must everyone simply make the best guess with the information they have and hope they guess correctly? A quick scan of the world's religions would make it appear so. However, Christianity stands out among other religions because it presents the opportunity for objective evaluation. The kind of evidence that supports the Christian faith is different from the kind of evidence that supports other religions.
