Sermon: Colossians 3:12-14 “Love”

Discipleship: Pray About Prayer From The Presence Centered Church

It's so obvious, it's usually overlooked. If God invites us to pray and promises to answer our prayers, and if one of our great concerns (and His) is our lack of prayer why would we not pray about our prayer life and that of our church? Why not pray about prayer? Wouldn't God be pleased with such a request? Wouldn't he rejoice that we were finally seeing our foundational need to be in constant communion with Him? Don't you imagine He would rush to our aid and begin to lift our wings in prayer in ways we could never do on our own?

Instead of condemning yourself about your prayerlessness, why not use those moments in simple intercession around one simple, power-packed, prayer from Luke 11:1; “Lord, teach us to pray!” Each word carries meaning.

Lord, Teach us to pray! We cannot teach ourselves. We are weak and ignorant about how to commune with You. We need a great Teacher. One who will not give up on us. One who will meet us where we are and lead us where we need to go. There is no One who knows more about the subject than You. So. LORD, teach us to pray!

Lord, Teach us to pray! Instruct us. Sit us down daily to learn the ways of prayer. Let us see things about prayer that we have never seen, then experience You in prayer in ways we never dreamed possible. Not only each me, O, Lord. but use me to teach others. To help them develop prayer as the foundation of their lives. Lord, TEACH us to pray!
