“That thou mayest walk in the way of good men, and keep the paths of the righteous.”

-Proverbs 2:20

The wicked and transgressors are cut off and rooted out from the promised land. They are cut off from Heaven and spend eternity separated from God in Hell, the final destination of the path they chose in life.
